... or Three. Take it to any Vote Center in State Senate District Thirty-six.

The Registrar of Voters office in Santa Ana also has a ballot drop box and is available for all voter services.

And Four. You can vote in-person at any of the Vote Centers, too.

Select Vote Centers in State Senate District Thirty-six open on February fifteenth. Ten additional

Vote Centers in State Senate District Thirty-six open on February twenty-fifth.

All Vote Centers and ballot drop boxes close at eight p.m. on February twenty-fifth. Our four drop

off locations will close at their normal business hours.
