

# STATEWIDE SPECIAL ELECTION CALENDAR

## NOVEMBER 4, 2025

**August 21, 2025  
(E-75)**

**GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMTION - ISSUANCE:** The Governor shall issue a proclamation calling for a Statewide Special Election and shall state the time of the election.

**October 6, 2025  
(E-29)**

**COMBINED VOTER INFORMATION GUIDE AND VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS MAILED:** Combined County Voter Information Guide and Vote-By-Mail ballots mailed to active registered voters.

**October 20, 2025  
(E-15)**

**LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE SPECIAL STATEWIDE ELECTION:** Last day to register to vote in the Special Statewide Election. The Voter Registration Form shall be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the county elections official by this date and effective upon receipt.

**October 21, 2025  
through  
November 4, 2025  
(E-14 – 0)**

**CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION PERIOD:** During the period 14 days prior to Election Day and including Election Day, an individual can go to the office of his/her county elections official to conditionally register to vote and vote a provisional ballot.

**October 25, 2025  
(E-10)**

**SELECT VOTE CENTERS OPEN:** Beginning 10 days before the day of the election, and continuing daily up to Election Day, select Vote Centers are open to the public.

**November 1, 2025  
(E-3)**

**ADDITIONAL VOTE CENTERS OPEN:** Beginning 3 days before the day of the election, and continuing daily up to Election Day, all Vote Centers are open to the public.

**November 4, 2025  
(E-0)**

**DEADLINE TO RETURN A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT:** A voter may drop off a voted Vote-By-Mail ballot at a drop box or Vote Center in the county by **November 4, 2025, 8:00 p.m.**

**IMPORTANT:** A mailed, voted ballot will count only if the return envelope is signed, dated, and postmarked no later than **Election Day, November 4, 2025** and is received no later than eight days (8\*) days after **Election Day, November 12, 2025.**

**December 2, 2025  
(E+28)**

**COMPLETE CANVASS OF OFFICIAL RETURNS AND CERTIFY RESULTS:** First date the county elections official may complete the canvass and certify the results.

\*The last day to receive postmarked ballots is a Holiday, the date moves forward to the next business day.
