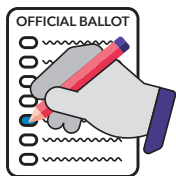

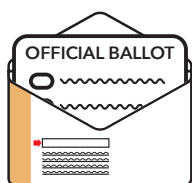
Mark, seal, and sign your envelope

USE THIS BALLOT TO VOTE SECURELY AT HOME!



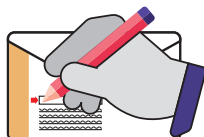
1. Mark your ballot

- Follow the directions on the ballot.
- Completely fill in the box next to your choice.



2. Seal your envelope

- Check that you have the return envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the envelope and seal the envelope.



3. Sign the envelope

- Date and sign your name on the back of the envelope in ink.
- Print your name and residential address.

4. Options for returning your ballot

Mail Your Ballot



Mail your ballot on or before Election Day (no postage required). For mail box locations visit ocvote.gov/mail

Secure Drop Box



Use one of our secure drop boxes located in the City of Santa Ana, Ward 3, and the Registrar of Voters. For locations visit ocvote.gov/dropbox

Vote Center



Drop off your ballot in-person at the Vote Center in the City of Santa Ana, Ward 3, or the Registrar of Voters' office. For locations and hours visit ocvote.gov/votecenter

Important additional info!

- If you make a mistake, call 714-567-7600 before Election Day.
- Your envelope must be signed, dated, and postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the seventh day after Election Day.

Tips for marking your vote-by-mail ballot and keeping it private.

Use a dark blue or black pen. Do not use pencil!

Do not write or sign your name on the ballot.
