



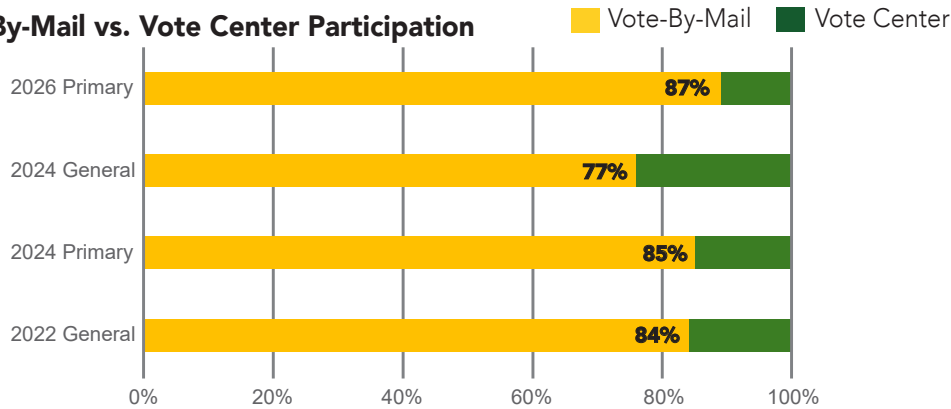

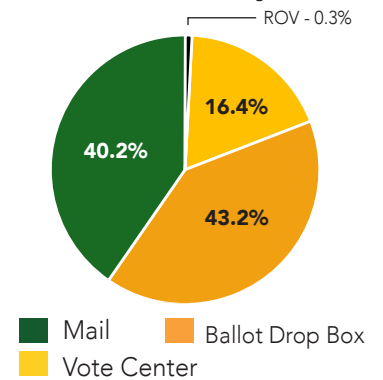

Vote-By-Mail vs. Vote Center Participation



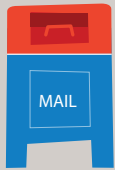
Vote-By-Mail Return Method 2026 Primary



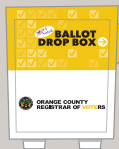

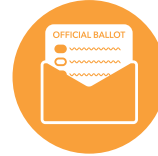

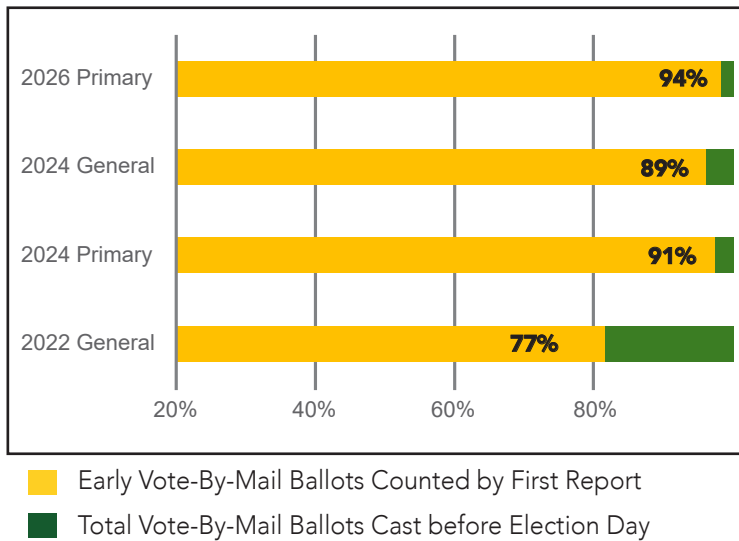

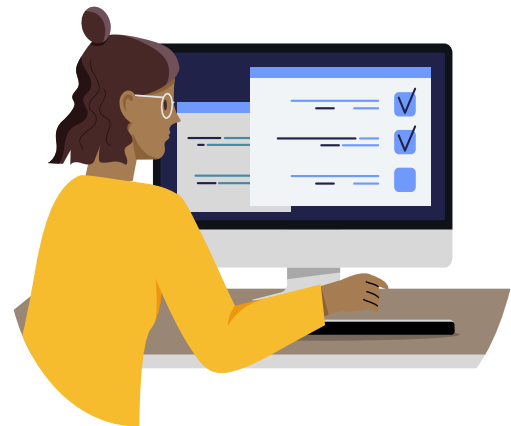
