Reduce urban runoff that pollutes our beaches.

Demand illegal immigration reform and curtail eminent domain abuses.

Support term limits - say no to Measure N extending terms for the Board of Supervisors from 8 to 12 years.

Public employee unions are spending hundreds of thousands of dollars to elect candidates to the Board of Supervisors. These same Supervisors vote for excessive pensions and benefits packages. It's no wonder that our County pension and healthcare system is \$3.7 billion in debt.

My answer is to require a vote of the people on any future increases in County employee pension benefits.
