

CALENDAR OF EVENTS FOR ORANGE COUNTY CITIES

November 2, 2010 GENERAL ELECTION

For City Clerk Use Only

July 12, 2010 (E-113)	Resolution calling election to Registrar of Voters. This is not a statutory deadline; however, it helps to have the resolution as soon as possible.
August 6, 2010 (E-88)	Last day to consolidate with General Election. Resolution containing a measure must be to Registrar of Voters by 5:00 p.m. on August 6, 2010. If you wish to have full text printed in the sample ballot, we need to have the full text by August 6, 2010.
August 6, 2010 (E-88)*	Last day for direct arguments and city attorney impartial analysis. If your Council passes a resolution prior to August 6, 2010, adjust the date accordingly.
August 7, 2010 through August 16, 2010 (E-87 - 78)	Public Review period for measure text, impartial analysis and direct arguments. Measure documents will be posted on the Registrar of Voters website.
August 9, 2010 (E-85)	Registrar of Voters will email measure letter designations to cities that have measures on the ballot.
August 16, 2010 (E-78)	Last day for rebuttal arguments. If your direct arguments are due prior to August 6, 2010, the rebuttals must be filed 10 days after the direct arguments.
August 17, 2010 through August 26, 2010 (E-77 - 68)	Public Review period for rebuttal arguments. All changes due to court action(s) must be finalized by August 26, 2010, 5:00 p.m., to be included in the Registrar of Voters sample ballot pamphlet.
September 23, 2010 (E-40)	Sample ballot pamphlet mailing begins approximately this date. Mailing completed by October 12, 2010.
September 23, 2010 (E-40)	Registrar of Voters will mail a list of polling places within your city. They will also be available on the City Clerk Partnership website. You will be notified when this posting occurs.

*Any documents received by the City late in the afternoon on E-88 may be given to ROV on next business day.

October 4, 2010 (E-29)	First day vote-by-mail ballots are available. All vote-by-mail ballots will be issued through the Registrar of Voters. If you receive requests at your City Hall, please forward to Registrar of Voters.
October 12, 2010 (E-21)	Last day to mail sample ballots.
October 18, 2010 (E-15)	Last day to register to vote for the November 2, 2010 General Election.
October 26, 2010 (E-7)	Last day to apply for regular vote-by-mail ballots.
October 26, 2010 (E-7)	Registrar of Voters will mail a CD containing the registered voters within your city.
October 27, 2010 through November 2, 2010 (E-6 - 0)	Emergency vote-by-mail ballots issued at Registrar of Voters office.
November 2, 2010 (E-0)	Election Day. Polls open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
November 3, 2010 (E+1)	Official Canvass begins.
November 28, 2010** (E+28)	Registrar of Voters will certify on or before this date.
