NOTICE OF ELECTION: The Registrar of Voters must publish once in a newspaper of general circulation the Notice of Election. The notice shall contain the date of the election; the offices for which candidates may be nominated; the qualifications for each office; and when and where nomination papers may be obtained. The Registrar of Voters shall deliver a copy of the published notice to the school district secretary, who shall post it.

NOMINATION PERIOD: Declaration of Candidacy forms may be obtained from and must be filed with the Registrar of Voters office from **October 15, 2007 through November 9, 2007, 5:00 p.m.**

CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS:

Each candidate may prepare a statement on a form provided by the Registrar of Voters. The statement may contain no more than 200 words, unless the governing body of the local agency has authorized the statement to contain 400 words. The statement must be filed at the same time the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. The statement may be withdrawn, **but not changed**, during the nomination period and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

The Registrar of Voters will estimate the total cost of printing and handling the candidates' statements and will require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance his/her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his/her statement included in the voter's pamphlet. This amount must be paid at the time the candidate's statement is filed. If there is an underpayment, the candidate shall be required to pay the balance of the cost incurred. Overpayments will be refunded within 30 days of the election.

December 7, 2007 through February 5, 2008 (E-60 – 0)	<u>RANDOMIZED ALPHABET DRAWING:</u> On this day, the Secretary of State shall conduct a drawing of the letters of the alphabet, the result of which shall be known as the randomized alphabet, to determine the order in which candidates appear on the presidential primary election ballot. § 13112
December 7, 2007 (E-60)	<u>LIST OF ABSENTEE VOTERS:</u> First day computer tapes are available for purchase indicating all voters who have been issued an absentee ballot. <u>MILITARY AND OVERSEAS BALLOTS:</u> Military and overseas ballots available to eligible voters on this date. §§ 3103, 3304, 3307

<p>January 7, 2008 through January 29, 2008 (E-29 - 7)</p>	<p><u>ABSENTEE VOTING:</u> Applications for absentee ballots available during this period from the Registrar of Voters office. <p>February 5, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>ELECTION DAY:</u> Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Ballots will be centrally counted at the Registrar of Voters office. §§ 14212, 15260</p>
<p>February 5, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>ABSENT VOTER BALLOTS RETURNED:</u> Deadline for the Registrar of Voters office to receive absentee ballots by mail or in person is February 5, 2008, 8:00 p.m. A voter may deliver his/her absentee ballot in person to the Registrar of Voters office or to any polling place in the county by the close of the polls on Election Day. §§ 3017, 3020</p>
<p>February 5, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>SEMI-OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS:</u> Beginning at 8:00 p.m. and continuing until completed, the Registrar of Voters will conduct the semi-official canvass of votes and report totals to the Secretary of State. §§ 15150, 15151</p>
<p>February 6, 2008 (E+1)</p>	<p><u>COMMENCE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS:</u> The Registrar of Voters will commence the official canvass of votes. §§ 10547, 15301</p>
<p>March 4, 2008 (E+28)</p>	<p><u>COMPLETE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS AND CERTIFY RESULTS BY THIS DATE:</u> The Registrar of Voters will certify the results of the election and prepare a statement of the results. § 15372</p>
<p>July 31, 2008 (E+177)</p>	<p><u>SEMI-ANNUAL CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS DUE:</u> Last day to file semi-annual campaign disclosure statements for all candidates and committees for the period January 20, 2008 through June 30, 2008. Gov't § 84200</p>
